New Danish trial of Ice Power Arthro Creme



82% experienced improvement with joint pain, morning stiffness and mobility

Recently finished Danish trial shows that Ice Power Arthro Creme has a positive effect on reducing joint pain. Osteopath D.O, M.R.O.DK.
